Welcome to the IBBC's Spring Conference 2024

It gives me immense pleasure to welcome you all to the 12th Iraq Day at The Mansion House.

I particularly welcome our large delegation coming from all parts of Iraq including Baghdad, the Kurdistan Region, Basrah, Mosul, and many other governorates. You have travelled a long distance and I congratulate you for overcoming the difficult and time-consuming task of obtaining a visa to enter this country.

Unfortunately, It has yet again become more difficult for Iraqis to obtain British visas. This is not a political decision but is due to the fact that more visitors from Iraq have overstayed the permitted time allocated in their visa and that a significant percentage of illegal immigrants arriving on small boats are of Iraqi origin. We have several officials from the Home Office with us today who will be pleased to meet with you to discuss the visa process and to inform you about legal ways of immigration open to all Iraqis who aspire to come to the United Kingdom.

A special thanks goes to the Lord Mayor of the City of London and to his excellent team at The Mansion House. We thank them for their support and for granting us permission to use this truly exceptional venue once more. This is of particular importance this year as we face a general election in 2 days' time and can therefore not have a British Minister attend this year's proceedings.

We are grateful for the attendance and contributions of the many Iraqi and UK officials, particularly to Prime Minister Mohammed Shiah al Sudani and his counterpart in Erbil, Prime Minister Masrour Barzani. Both have been personally briefed about this event and are giving us their explicit support.

With parliamentary elections taking place in 2 days' time in Britain we do not have a British Minister attending. However, in addition to the Home Office we have representatives from the Foreign, Commonwealth & Develpment Office FCDO, Department of Business & Trade DBT and the UK Export Finance UKEF attending as well as delegates from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development EBRD. Yesterday you heard from our Vice President and former Trade Minister Lord Green and today we are fortunate to hear from Rupert Soames, Chairman of the Confederation of British Industry, our President Baroness Nicholson and our Vice President Lord Howell.

In 2024 we celebrate the IBBC's 15th anniversary. IBBC and Iraq have come a long way since June 2009 when we launched ourselves under the leadership of Baroness Nicholson at the House of Lords. A first trade delegation and conference in Baghdad was held in September of that year, and trade delegations and conferences in Basrah and Erbil followed soon after, and we went on to become what we are now. A display in the Saloon shows some of the milestones passed in the last 15 years.

WELCOME

Despite the conflict in Palestine and its wider ramifications for the region, Iraq has remained stable and peaceful. Security remains consistently good and as in last year and previous years we called on Britain and other countries to review their travel advice for Iraq. We believe that changing the advice is the single biggest step that can be taken to improve access to the Iraqi market for international business.

In his new paper for the IBBC advisory council, launched today, Professor Frank Gunter cheers Iraq's economic reform with some caution. The Government has taken measures to improve economic prospects, notably in de-dollarizing the economy, pushing for a consolidation of the banking sector and passing a 3-year budget.

However Iraq's overall business environment remains inhospitable, the country's structural problems are not being tackled and are growing all the time. In 2050 Iraq is due to have a population of 80 million. To provide meaningful jobs to its population the Iraqi Government must free the private sector from its shackles and literally make space for it. There needs to be less bureaucracy and red tape, and the state has to be shrunken massively to allow for significant and exponential private sector growth. Many if not all our Members already succeed despite this inhospitable environment and demonstrate private sector success to others. Many more success stories like those of our members are required for Iraq to truly prosper.

I would like to thank all our Members who provide IBBC with leadership and funding. I specifically thank those Members who sponsor this conference, AAA Holding, Sardar Group, Trade Bank of Iraq, CJ-ICM and Hydro-C. A special thanks goes to our travel partner London Sky, very strong supporters of the organisation, who have recently given us an office in Erbil.

IBBC is committed to a free and prosperous Iraq and has a track record going back 15 years to show for it. We believe in a promising future for Iraq and stand by its people and government.

I invite you to make the best possible use of the expertise across many sectors gathered here today. Please make use of the different roundtable discussions taking place alongside the main sessions throughout the day. There is no need to register for these in advance. and I also invite you to visit the exceptional exhibition on Gertrude Bell brought to us by Newcastle University.

I very much hope that you will find your time with us valuable and enjoyable.



Challenging Legacies The Kingdom of Iraq and Gertrude Bell



We are delighted to bring a showcase of our multi venue exhibition Challenging Legacies to the IBBC Spring Conference 2024.

Challenging Legacies: the Kingdom of Iraq and Gertrude Bell examines the events leading up to the creation of the Kingdom of Iraq in 1921, considering the impact and legacy of the First World War and the British administration on the country as well as the role of archaeologist and colonial administrator, Gertrude Bell (1868 – 1926).

Through Newcastle University's UNESCO Memory of the World registered Gertrude Bell Archive, Challenging Legacies focuses on the dual narratives of Bell and Iraq, primarily the 17-year period from 1909 to 1926 where their fates intertwined. Representing them independently and together using original archival material and newly digitised photographs from the Gertrude Bell Archive, the exhibition considers their respective complex histories.

Challenging Legacies aims to educate, enlighten, and encourage critical and nuanced thought towards Bell and the wider British colonial legacy in the Middle East whilst also exploring Iraq's rich history and global significance. The exhibition has been designed to be suitable for visitors of all backgrounds with no prior knowledge of the subjects covered expected, and hope delegates can help us bring this shared heritage to new audiences. **IBBC Tech Forum**

Lord Green of Hurstpierpoint

Stephen Green studied at Oxford University, graduating in 1969 in Politics, Philosophy and Economics. He also obtained a Masters Degree in Political Science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1975.

He was created a Life Peer in 2010 and was appointed Minister of State for Trade and Investment in January 2011. He retired from this position in December 2013. He sits in the House of Lords as a cross-bencher.

Lord Green began his career in 1970 with the British Government's Ministry of Overseas Development. In 1977, he joined McKinsey & CoInc.

He joined The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation in 1982. He became Group Chief Executive in 2003 and Group Chairman 2006. He retired from HSBC in December 2010. He served as a non-executive director of BASF until 2010. He was Chair of the Natural History Museum from 2014 to 2023.

He is Chair of Asia House and Honorary President of The Chartered Institute of Export and International Trade.

Stephen Green has written several books, including; Reluctant Meister – How Germany's Past is Shaping its European Future [2014]; The European Identity – Historical and Cultural Realities We Cannot Deny [2015]; Brexit and The British [2017]; The Human Odyssey [2019].

He has won four major and multiple minor awards for teaching excellence. Based on his two years in Iraq as an economic advisor to the US Government, Frank wrote The Political Economy of Iraq: Restoring Balance in a Post-Conflict Society (Edward Elgar Publishing, 2013). This book was published in both English and Arabic and was selected as an "Outstanding Academic Title" by Choice magazine. His most recent work, "Immunizing Iraq Against al Qaeda 3.0" (Orbis, 2018, Vol. 62, No. 3, pp. 389-408), discusses the possible economic causes of political instability in Iraq. Professor Mark Jackson, Newcastle University

As a Professor of Byzantine Archaeology, Mark is responsible for teaching, research, and mentoring students. Additionally, they direct the Archaeology MA Programmes, overseeing curriculum development and student admissions. Mark also co-curates the Gertrude Bell Archive, preserving and managing documents and artifacts related to Gertrude Bell.
